Zonta members are building a better world for women and girls in their local communities and beyond! Read the stories below highlighting how Zonta clubs are taking action and saying NO to violence against women and girls.

Z clubs in Hong Kong say NO to violence against women

Zonta Club of Hong Kong's six Z clubs said NO by creating and submitting digital posters that showcased a visual representation of the Zonta Says NO to Violence Against Women and 16 Days of Activism campaigns.

The student clubs posted physical posters around their school, emailed them to fellow students and uploaded them to their respective educational platforms and Instagram accounts where students were encouraged to like and to share the post – all helping to inspire and spread the message.



Emphasis is placed on the severity of domestic violence as well as the urgency to spread awareness about this problem and protect women's rights. The digital poster was promoted to the whole school via the school's educational platform and is expected to reach at least 750 students and teachers.

Zonta clubs of Ibadan I and II collaborate in 16 days of activism for the elimination of violence against women

The Zonta clubs of Ibadan I and II, Nigeria, invited the press to cover the unveiling of billboards and the beginning of the Zonta Says NO activities in the city.

The clubs also carried hand-held placards while parading in different locations. They encouraged reporting of gender-based violence (GBV) cases, which club members of the legal profession will handle pro bono.
