

Chapter 5

District 01 - North America¹

Since 1920, Zonta International has grouped clubs by district. The following is information on the formation of District 01. As of December 2019 District 01 had 12 clubs in the USA and Canada: two in Maine, seven in Massachusetts, one in New Hampshire and two in the Canadian province of Nova Scotia.

Zonta District 01:

- won two Centennial Anniversary Grants during the 2018-2020 biennium (ZC of Berkshire County and ZC of Malden)
- recognizes clubs with an annual Governor's Award for Overall Excellence in Service
- has a history of members serving at the international level
- has had local scholarship recipients selected to receive international awards
- is involved in local service by partnering with such organizations as the Rape Response Services of Maine, Bangor Public Library, Lund Home, Ozanam Place, Caps for Kids, The Salvation Army, Greater Boston Food Bank, Dress for Success, and Metro Immigration Settlement Association of Canada
- raises funds by hosting activities such as Marketplace Fairs, Women Making a Difference, Silent No More, and golf tournaments
- advocates for legislation of human trafficking as a crime, for ending violence in Darfur, and in support of the Breast Cancer Patient Protection Act.²
- has had a history of Amelia Earhart Fellows.

Timeline of district history highlights

1928: Clubs from Massachusetts belonged to District A.

1930–1946: Clubs from Connecticut, Maine, Massachusetts and Vermont belonged to District I, Region A³.

1947: An effective redistricting took place. District I was founded for clubs from the following states:

- Connecticut, USA
- Maine, USA
- Massachusetts, USA
- New Hampshire, USA
- Rhode Island, USA (1958–1961)
- Vermont, USA
- Newfoundland, Canada (1951–2006)
- Nova Scotia, Canada
- Prince Edward Island, Canada (1963–2006).

From 1947 to 2019, District I (referred to as District 01 from 1990) had the following clubs:

1947: 20 clubs.

1952: 25 clubs.

1961: 30 clubs.

1962: 29 clubs.

1964: 30 clubs.

1965: 29 clubs.

1966: 29 clubs.

1970: 29 clubs.

1972: 26 clubs.

1974: 28 clubs (no areas organized).

1978: 27 clubs (one area organized).

1981: 29 clubs (four areas organized).

1983: 32 clubs (four areas organized).

1990: 37 clubs with 1,096 members⁴.

1995: 35 clubs (five areas organized).

2002: 27 clubs (five areas organized).

2006: 22 clubs (four areas organized but the number of areas was reduced during the 2006–2008 biennium).

2016: 16 clubs (four areas organized: Area 01 -four clubs, Area 02 -five clubs, Area 03 -three clubs and Area 04 -four clubs).

2018: 275 members.

2019: 253 members.⁵

2020: 230 members.⁶
