

Representation at the United Nations and Council of Europe Policy

Introduction

Zonta International is recognized as having: (1) general consultative status with the United Nations Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC); (2) consultative status with the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO); (3) special relationships with United Nations entities promoting women's rights; and (4) participatory status with the Council of Europe.

Representation

Zonta International may choose to assign representatives to the United Nations and to the Council of Europe. Representatives shall be appointed by the Zonta International presidentelect with the approval of the Zonta International Board prior to the biennium in which they will serve. Representatives shall function in accordance with the guidelines approved by the Zonta International Board.
