Last month, I had the remarkable opportunity to <u>visit</u> <u>Mozambique</u> and witness the initiatives that are being implemented to prevent child marriage. I was truly impressed by the programs that are a part of our <u>Ending Child Marriage international service project</u> with UNICEF USA and UNFPA.

During my visit, I was concerned to learn that a main driver for child marriage in the country is climate change. When homes are destroyed by cyclones, girls are in danger of being sold to a "husband" so that their families have money for rebuilding. However, I was encouraged when I spoke to the participants and asked them why they were taking part in the program. I was happy to hear that they recognized the importance of ending child marriage. They responded by saying that ending child marriage would benefit their community as a whole. Through education, girls and women can develop their skills and give back to their village and community. I found their perspective inspiring and insightful.

The progress made in preventing child marriage has been possible because of the selfless and generous gifts of Zonta members and friends to the Zonta Foundation for Women.
