### 2019 Rose Day donations exceed last year's

Your donation to the Rose Fund enables Zonta to empower women and girls worldwide.



Steadfast advocates for the rights of women and girls were recognized by Zonta supporters on **Rose Day** with a donation in their honor to the Zonta International Foundation Rose Fund.

This year, the Foundation benefited from US\$44,000 in tribute gifts, an increase of US\$12,000, or 37%, over last year. These donations enable Zonta to elevate women and girls worldwide through projects and programs such as Let Us Learn Madagascar and the Amelia Earhart Fellowship.

Let Us Learn is one of the two projects supported by the International Service Project Fund. Below are examples<sup>1</sup> of the impact your contribution could provide. Provisions range from pedagogical materials to supporting construction of classrooms. For more examples, click the button to the right.

**US\$63** could increase access to services for one child who is a victim of violence or at-risk.

**US\$180** could support one family for an entire year with a monthly cash transfer used to meet their basic needs.

**US\$380** could provide catch-up classes for three students who have been out of school for at least one year.
