

## THE IMPACT OF YOUR SUPPORT

**\$50** Could provide one adolescent with access to a program that promotes critical reflection about social norms related to manhood and masculinity for boys and promotes equitable gender roles, empowerment in interpersonal relationships, and sexual and reproductive health and rights in girls.



**\$100** Could provide one adolescent girl with access to quality, comprehensive and gender-sensitive adolescent health care, with an emphasis on mental health and violence prevention, and who will attend schools that can address all types of violence.



**\$250** Could provide three adolescent girls with access to quality, comprehensive and gender-sensitive adolescent health care, with an emphasis on mental health and violence prevention, and who will attend schools that can address all types of violence.



**\$500** Could provide seven adolescent girls with access to quality, comprehensive and gender-sensitive adolescent health care, with an emphasis on mental health and violence prevention, and who will attend schools that can address all types of violence.



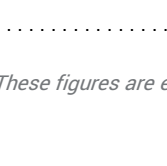
**\$1,000** Could provide 28 adolescents with access to a program that promotes critical reflection about social norms related to manhood and masculinity for boys and promotes equitable gender roles, empowerment in interpersonal relationships, and sexual and reproductive health and rights in girls.



**\$5,000** Could provide 65 adolescent girls with access to quality, comprehensive and gender-sensitive adolescent health care, with an emphasis on mental health and violence prevention, and who will attend schools that can address all types of violence.



**\$10,000** Could provide 280 adolescents with access to a program that promotes critical reflection about social norms related to manhood and masculinity for boys and promotes equitable gender roles, empowerment in interpersonal relationships, and sexual and reproductive health and rights in girls.



**\$15,000** Could provide 200 adolescent girls with access to quality, comprehensive and gender-sensitive adolescent health care, with an emphasis on mental health and violence prevention, and who will attend schools that can address all types of violence.
