



# THE IMPACT OF YOUR SUPPORT

We hope you will consider a gift to support The Global Programme to End Child Marriage. Below are examples of the impact your gifts could provide:



**\$55** could provide antenatal care kits to one pregnant adolescent girl in Niger, promoting better health, including preventing anemia and low birth weight of newborns, frequent health threats for girls who are married at a young age and their children.



**\$100** could support community facilitators in Ghana to use communication materials to engage 500 people to have improved understanding of issues affecting girls and women.



**\$500** could mobilize 50 community members in Mozambique around prevention of child marriage.



**\$5,000** could support a Girls Club for a year within a school in Ethiopia. Girls Clubs are making a difference in reducing child marriage by empowering girls through life skills trainings.



**\$10,000** could reach over 360 people in India through an awareness campaign on social issues, including child marriage.



**\$20,000** could support the transition of 500 girls in Burkina Faso from primary to post primary support through scholarship, school kits and tutoring support. Increasing girls' transition to secondary school is a key strategy for reducing rates of child marriage.
